November 22, 1963 – John Fitzgerald Kennedy, the 35th President of the United States, was assassinated while riding in a motorcade in Dallas, Texas. Texas Governor John B. Connally, in the same car as Kennedy, was seriously wounded. A suspect, Lee Harvey Oswald was arrested. Vice President Lyndon B. Johnson was sworn in as President.

November 23, 1936 – Life, the photo-journalism magazine created by Henry R. Luce, was first published!

Major League Baseball player Roberto Clemente, 38, was killed when a plane he chartered and was traveling on to take relief supplies to earthquakedevastated Nicaragua crashed shortly after takeoff from Puerto Rico.

DECEMBER 31, 1985 – Singer Rick Nelson, 45, and six other people were killed when fire broke out aboard a DC-3 that was taking the group to a New Year's Eve performance in Dallas, Texas.

DECEMBER 27, 1947 – The original version of the puppet character Howdy Doody made his TV debut on NBC's "Puppet Playhouse."

DECEMBER 28, 1999 – Clayton Moore, 85, television's "Lone Ranger", died in West Hills, California.

DECEMBER 28, 1945 – Congress officially recognized the Pledge of Allegiance.

DECEMBER 25, 1990 – The World Wide Web, the system providing quick access to websites over the internet, was born in Geneva, Switzerland, as computer scientists Tim Berners-Lee and

Robert Caillau created the world's first hyperlinked webpage.
